**THEME: Stronger Together!** 

**WHO MAY ENTER:** All students ages 8 - 18 throughout Brazoria County are eligible.

Contest divisions: (Category I: ages 8-10, Category II: Ages 11-12, Category III: Ages 13-15

and Category IV: 16-18.)

HOW TO ENTER: Students may submit posters beginning December 1, 2020 through January 28, 2021 to any

Brazoria County library.

Deadline for receiving posters is January 28, 2021 by 4:00 pm.

Late poster will not be accepted.

**DETAILS:** Express what Stronger Together means and how it can be displayed in your community. Winners will be contacted by phone and prizes will be awarded to first, second, and third place winners. **Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the award ceremony date/time/location will be determined at a later** 

## **CONTEST INFORMATION:**

- 1. The poster must be created by a youth from Brazoria County.
- 2. Well-known cartoon figures or corporate trademarks may not be used on posters, because they are copyrighted or legally protected. NO PERSONAL PHOTOS ARE ALLOWED.
- **3.** All posters must be sized on 14" x 22" dimensions (one-half a standard poster board size). They may be horizontal or vertical.
- **4.** Posters may be produced by any medium-watercolor, ink, crayon, acrylic, charcoal, oils, collage, so long as they are **not** three-dimensional objects.
- **5.** The <u>submitter's name</u>, <u>phone number</u>, <u>age</u>, <u>school</u>, and <u>school district</u>, and a brief artwork interpretive statement, should be affixed to the back of the poster board in the upper left hand corner.

- **7.** Contestants will be evaluated on the following criteria:
  - **A.** Development of theme
  - **B.** Color
  - C. Originality/Creativity
  - **D.** Neatness
  - E. Complexity
- **8.** Once submitted, the poster becomes property of the MLKCC to be used as the committee sees fit for display in the community or media, and may not be returned. The selected poster may be digitally altered to assure quality reproduction.
